

## **OW Oil for Ebony**

### **Description**

Ebony fingerboards are highly valued in musical instruments for their hardness, durability, and rich, dark aesthetics.

Taking care of a violin's fingerboard is essential to maintaining the instrument in good condition and ensuring quality sound. The fingerboard is the part of the violin where the strings are pressed with the fingers, and over time, it can accumulate dirt, grease, and wear.

Therefore, frequent cleaning of this part is necessary, as well as keeping the wood hydrated and nourished to prevent it from drying out and cracking.

OW Oil for Ebony is a product that contains high-quality natural oils that penetrate deeply into the wood, providing long-lasting hydration that protects and prolongs the piece's life. Additionally, it enhances the natural beauty of the wood.

It can be used on high-quality ebony parts to protect and enhance their appearance and on previously stained pieces, contributing to better protection and colour durability.

### Composition

Combination of natural oils and cleaning agents.

Does not contain harsh solvents.

Safe, non-flammable, non-irritating.

Low-odor liquid.

#### **Application**

Completely clean the fingerboard to remove any dirt, oil, or residue.

Use a clean cloth to apply the oil. Soak the cloth with a small amount of product and spread it lengthwise across the entire piece. The product spreads easily, so only a small amount is needed for each coat. Apply a thin layer and remove any excess product with a soft cloth to avoid buildup. Excess oil can attract dirt and leave sticky residues.

OW Oil for Ebony dries in a few hours. If a second coat is desired, wait until the next day to ensure the first application is completely dry.

Once the product is completely dry, rub the surface with a clean cloth.

If the ebony piece to be treated has been previously stained, OW Oil for

Ebony can be applied to ensure proper colour durability and good condition. Apply once or twice, with a 24-hour interval. This will protect the colour and the wood.

Testing the oil on a small, inconspicuous area of the fingerboard is always recommended to ensure it does not cause any adverse reactions.

It is not necessary to apply oils very frequently. A couple of times a year is usually sufficient, depending on the climate and instrument use.

<u>Caution</u>: The OW Oil for Ebony must not come into contact with the varnish. It may damage the surface of the instrument.

#### **Storage**

Storage time: more than a year in its original container, well-sealed and protected from the weather (sheltered and at temperatures between 5 and 35°C).

Keep the container tightly closed and in a cool place and avoid direct exposure to light. Avoid heat sources, radiation, static electricity, and contact with food. Under these conditions, the product remains stable for over a year.

## Safety

According to Regulation No. 1272/2008 (CLP), this product is not classified as a hazardous substance or mixture.





Avoid contact with eyes and skin. In case of contact, rinse immediately with water. Do not ingest. Keep out of reach of children.
